


Clinical Context:

46 yo, IgG 4 associated Cholangiopathy with suspected mass in the hepatic fork



MRCP: diffuse dilatation of the intrahepatic bile ducts, accentuated in the left lobe of the liver, wall-thickened DHC and intrahepatic bile ducts. Suspected solid mass in the region of the hepatic fork.



EUS: Irregular DHC medium wall with intraluminal swelling and stenosis DD tumour-infiltrated



Cholangioscopy: normal right bile ducts



Cholangioscopy: left bile ducts with inflammatory features
